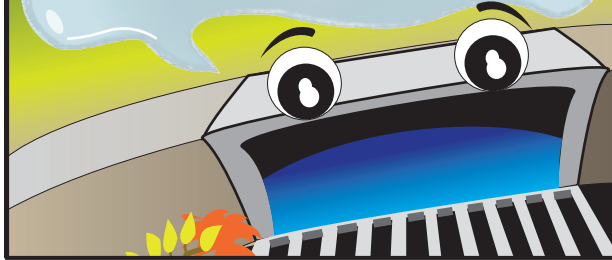
The litter is in the trash!
